C. SB FY19-40 - SGA Training Policy - Senator Sharp asking about the requirements for the training - Senator Sharp suggest that we do the training before we get appointed. - Senator Christensen makes it clear that we don't have to vote on this if we feel uncomfortable. - Rules reinstated - First reading for this bill. Senator Christensen thinks the bill should have some work done to it.
